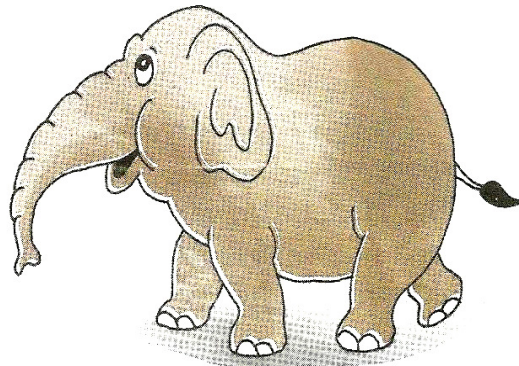


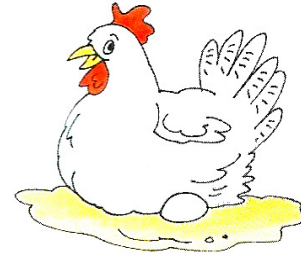

I have a ball.

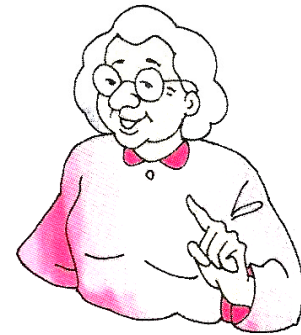


This is an elephant.

Put a or an before the words.



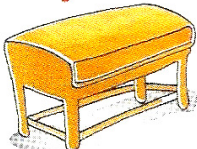
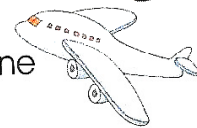
