- Give examples to support your views
- Present arguments in a coherent, logical and convincing manner

4. Comparison and contrast

- Give views contrary to yours
- Argue as to why your views are better

5. Conclusion

- Summing up___consolidation of ideas.
- Offering suggestions
- Personal observations and predictions
