The clock is **on** the wall.

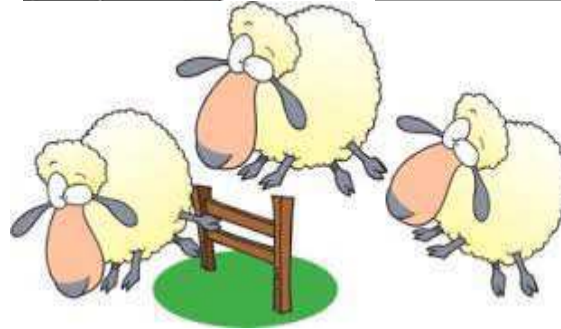
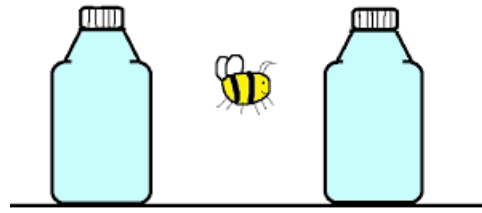
2. Where are the flowers?

3. Where is the ball?

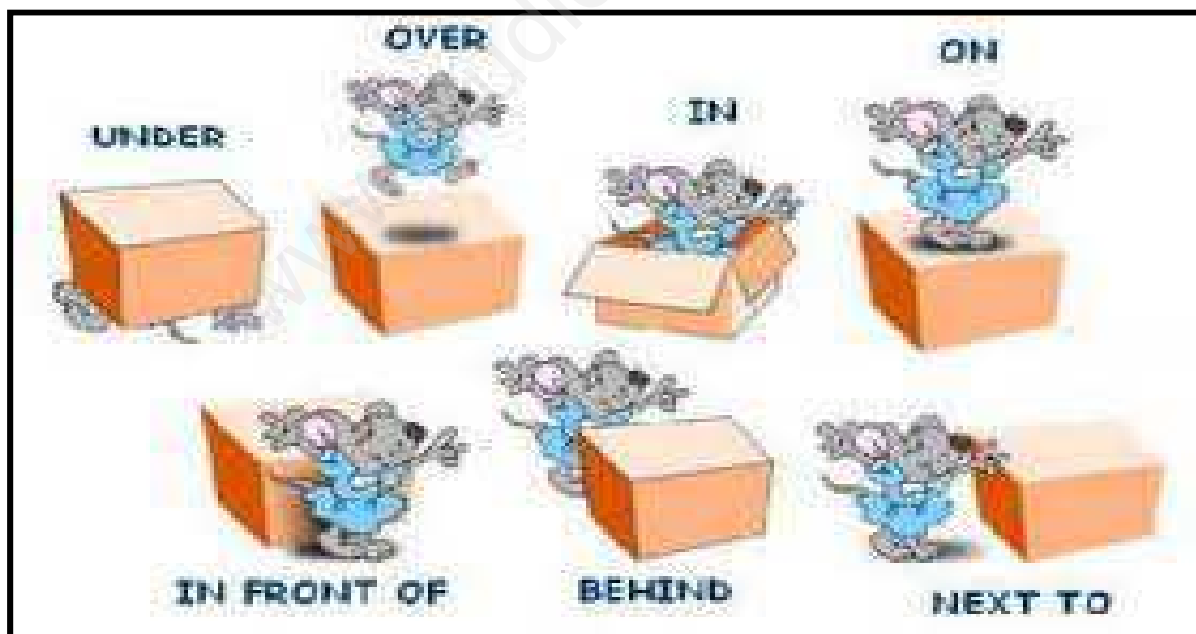
The ball is **under** the table.

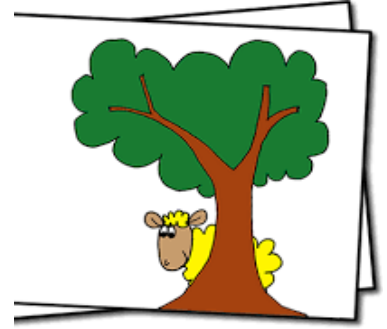

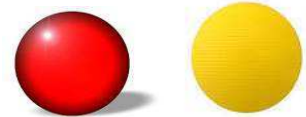
