Recalling Pronouns

A pronoun is a word that is used in place of a noun or a group of words that acts like a noun. I, he, she, he, she, it, we, we, you, they are called personal pronouns.

E.g. Altaf told Ashraf that Altaf would help Ashraf.

Altaf told Ashraf that he would help him.

The words in bold are used in place of nouns. They are called **pronouns.**

The various forms of personal pronouns are:

	singular	plural
First person	I, me ,mine, myself	We, us, our, ourselves
Second person	You, your ,yourself	You, your ,yourselves
Third person	He, his, him, she, her, hers, it, himself, herself, itself	They, them, theirs ,themselves
