We wear clothes to look decent and smart. Clothes also protect us from heat, wind, rain, cold and insect bites. The kind of clothes we wear depend upon the climate in which we live. The part of the world or country where we come from influences the way we dress up. Also, our dress depends upon the occasion. Children in schools and some people doing a special job like policemen, postmen and pilots wear a special dress called the uniform.
