2. Read the following chocolate cake recipe and answer the following:

Ingredients
2 cups baking flour
2 cups sugar
2 tsp baking powder
2/3 cup cocoa powder
2 tsp salt
3 eggs
1/3 cooking oil
2 tsp vanilla extract
1 tsp cinnamon
$1 / 2$ lemon zest

## Instructions

1. Mix baking flour, sugar, baking powder, cocoa, and salt thoroughly until you have a single solid color.
2. Add eggs, oil, vanilla, and salt.
3. Use an electric beater on a high setting for 1 minute.
4. Pour the contents into an $11 \times 7$ pan.
5. Cover the top of the batter with the cinnamon and lemon zest.
6. Bake at 355 degrees Fahrenheit for 45 minutes
7. If you want a plain cake instead of a chocolate taste, what ingredient might you leave out?
