1. Below you can see a set of instructions for making Cottage Cheese. Complete the following paragraph which describes how cottage cheese is made :

- Take one litre of milk and juice of a lemon.
- Pour the milk into a pan and bring it slowly to boil.
- While stirring milk continuously, add lemon juice.
- Continue to stir gently till the milk gets curdled.
- Set it aside to cool.
- When it gets cool, strain the curdled milk through a sieve of muslin.
- Squeeze out the liquid whey; press the cheese under a flat weight.

- Let it stand for five minutes.
- Serve before/after meal.
